Wedding Flowers

Floral decoration should never impede the approach to, or the encircling of the altar or any of the ritual movement and action. For this reason, we recommend the placement of two bouquets on either side of the tabernacle.

If flowers are to be used to decorate the ends of the pews, they should be used at regular intervals along the length of the aisle, enhancing the whole worship space. *Such arrangements should not be limited to the first few pews, serving as floral "reserved" signs.*

We welcome any floral arrangements you may wish to leave in the church after the celebration of your wedding. Your flowers would continue to enhance the parish worship and would be a fine gift to St. Maximilian Kolbe. We also respect your plans to bring these arrangements to your reception hall.
