

Paperwork/Marriage License

The paperwork establishes your freedom to marry in the Church. In order to record the marriage in the parish archives, you will need to complete some biographical information and a testimony of your intent to enter into Christian marriage. If you were not baptized at St. Mary's of the Lake Church, Church of the Epiphany or St. Rose, you will need a copy of your Baptismal Certificate which is dated not more than 6 months prior to the wedding date.

A civil marriage license must be obtained from any Town Clerk in New York State. There is a 24-hour waiting period, and the license is valid for 60 days.
