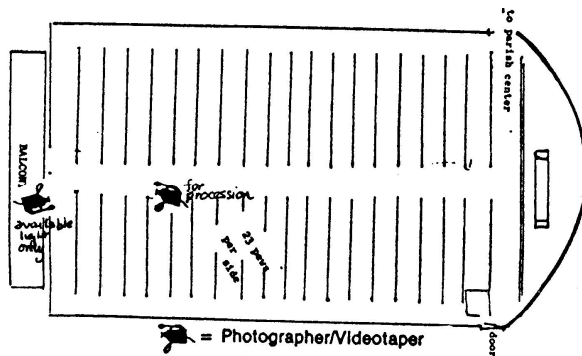


## Photography and Video-Taping

The liturgy during which you celebrate your marriage is a sacred moment of rejoicing in prayer, song and gesture. While we understand your desire to record this moment, we ask that you observe the following:

1. We have carefully studied the different locations from which pictures might be taken, and the resulting impact of the assembly's prayer. The diagram below indicates several places from which professional photographers or videographers may take pictures *using available light only*.
2. Photographers and videographers may not roam around the church once the liturgy has begun.



3. Only the lighting already available in the church may be used.
4. After the wedding, provided there is no conflict with other scheduled liturgies, the church will be available for additional pictures. Due reverence for the Blessed Sacrament must be observed.  
**Note:** There is not much time after a 2 PM Saturday wedding for photographs, since the altar must be set up for the afternoon Mass before the start of confessions at 3:30 PM. You are welcome to use the facilities of the Parish Center or the grounds.
5. Every effort should be made to let wedding guests know that picture taking and filming is limited to the professionals hired by the bride and groom, and that their main function is to join in the prayer and song of this joyous occasion.
